

MULTILEVEL COUPON FOR MAGENTO 2 USER GUIDE

Introduction

Multilevel Coupon Applier for Magento 2 is an extension that allows merchants to gather multiple discounts under the same coupon code.

The extension allows you to create special coupons where you can include an unlimited number of cart price rules. With Multilevel Coupon Applier, you don't have to create multiple coupons for different types of discounts, and there is no need to promote a few discount codes at the same time.

On the storefront, the extension works the following way: the customer enters the coupon code, and the extension automatically applies the price rule which conditions fits the products in the cart.

Magento Compatibility

Magento Open Source 2.4.x

Adobe Commerce 2.4.x

PHP 7.4, 8.1, 8.2

Installation

1. Unpack the zip file provided into the root folder of your Magento 2 installation.
2. From a command line run:

```
bin/magento module:enable Neklo_Core
```

```
bin/magento module:enable Neklo_MultilevelCoupon
```

```
bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

If Magento is in Production mode, the following commands should also be run:

```
bin/magento setup:di:compile
```

```
bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
```

Installation via Composer from Neklo

To install the available packages you need to add our repository to your composer configuration with the following command:

```
composer config repositories.neklo composer https://composer.neklo.com
```

Next install the package with the command:

```
composer require neklo/module-multilevelcoupon
```

When prompted, enter your Authentication details.

Composer authentication keys can be found in your account under My Downloadable Products.

```
bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

If Magento is in Production mode, the following commands should also be run:

```
bin/magento setup:di:compile
```

```
bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
```

Installation via Composer from Adobe Marketplace

Install the package with the command:

```
composer require neklo/module-multilevelcoupon
```

```
bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

If Magento is in Production mode, the following commands should also be run:

```
bin/magento setup:di:compile
```

```
bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
```


Creating Cart Price Rules

Multilevel Coupon Applier doesn't require any configuration and is enabled instantly after the installation. You need to have more than one active Cart Price Rule to assign them to the Multilevel Coupon later. To create or edit Cart Price Rules follow these steps:

1. Log into your **Admin Panel**.
2. Go to **Marketing > Cart Price Rules**.
3. Click on **Add New Rule** if you need to create a new rule, or edit the existing ones.
4. Click **Save** to apply the changes.

Creating Multilevel Coupons

To create and configure a new Multilevel Coupon or edit existing ones, go to **Marketing > Multilevel Coupon > Multilevel Coupon tab**.


1. In the **Coupon Name** field, enter the name for the multilevel coupon.
2. In the **Coupon Code** field, assign a coupon code that customers will use at the checkout.
3. In the **Select Coupon** drop-down list, select one or more cart price rules for this multilevel coupon. The cart price rules marked with a tick will be valid for this coupon.
4. Choose the current **Status** for the multilevel coupon.
5. Click **Save** to apply the changes.



Important Note: sub coupons for shipping can't be added to the multilevel coupon.

Duplicate Coupon

The Multilevel coupon can be duplicated with the same code and configuration.



- 1. Row ID** – Coupon ID number.
- 2. Coupon Name** – Coupon name entered when a coupon is created .
- 3. Coupon Code** – An assigned coupon code that customers will use at the checkout.
- 4. Order Number** – Order number where a coupon code is applied by a Customer.
- 5. Created** – Order date.
- 6. Grand Total** – Paid amount after all discounts.
- 7. Total Discount Amount** – Discount amount calculated by summing all price rules of a multilevel coupon.
